The Pastor's Corner

Every Sacrament has its own gifts and graces making them all important to the life of the individual Catholic and the life of the Universal Church. Of course Baptism is the gate to the other Sacraments. Without Baptism, it is not possible to receive the other Sacraments, and if someone did, they would have no effect.

As we think about the unique gifts and graces offered by each Sacrament, it makes me wonder why so many people today have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Confirmation is much more than our personal acceptance of Jesus Christ and His Church. The Sacrament of Confirmation "brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace."

Through Baptism, we are united more deeply in the grace of "divine filiation". The sacrament strengthens and solidifies our union with Christ. We receive more gifts from the Holy Spirit and the gifts we already have are deepened. Confirmation makes our bond with the Church "more perfect". And finally, we are given a "special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action".

We often hear people say that the Church is hypocritical. If we allow the Holy Spirit to make active within us the gifts and graces of our Confirmation, we will be the "true witnesses" that the Church and the world need today.
